Rules & Guidelines

- This show follows all rules of MCLA and MCGA.

Entries & Eligibility

- All Entries are non-refundable.
- Open to all youth age 7 to 21 on January 1, 2026.
- Show Age determined as of January 1st of the current year. Must be show age to exhibit.

Classes & Show Structure

- The total numbers of animals entered will determine number of classes and class sizes. Show committee reserves the right to combine any classes deemed not to meet minimum entry requirements.
- Classes will be determined by individual animal weights and total number of animals.
- No min or max weight. All animals will be weighed by a show official.
- Animals will show in the class they are assigned.

Animal Requirements & Health

- All animals must meet MDARD and/or USDA official ID requirements.
- Any animals with clinical signs of infectious, contagious, or toxicological disease will not be permitted to show and should not be unloaded at the show site. Health Check conducted at show registration.
- All lambs must have USDA Scrapie ID Tag.
- Lambs/Goats must be sheared/shaved prior to weigh in (except doe goats showing w/hair).
- Market lambs will show by white face, black face or speckled faced.
- Speckled faced lambs must be 50% or more white coverage on head, ears and legs.
- Exhibitors must show their own animal unless multiple in class
- Animals may be shown by only one exhibitor

Facility & Setup

- Limited electricity - Generators highly recommended.
- Show from your trailer. No Pens.
- No use of other barns on fairgrounds.

Conduct & Responsibilities

- All judge and/or show committee decisions are final.
- Failure to adhere to any rules shall result in the disqualification of the entry and/or exhibitor.
- The show committee encourages all exhibitors to take appropriate biosecurity measures to help protect their animals and Michigan's livestock industry.
- Bring rakes and trash bags to clean up area prior to leaving.

Additional Activities

- The educational quiz has no entry fee, but will have awards to the top 3 in each age group.
