Rules and Guidelines for Show

- Awards and Payouts for Showmanship, Top 5 Ewes, Top 5 Market Lambs and Class winners will be based on number of entries
- All classes are open to youth 21 and under as of January 1, 2026
- Showmanship classes offered for 6 and under w/mentor (peewee showmanship)
- You must show from trailers.
- Limited electric available, generators are encouraged
- Wash racks will be available
- Market Lambs will show as white-faced, natural or black-faced
- Commercial ewes will show by weight
- All sheep must have USDA scrapie ID tags and abide by MDARD exhibition identification guidelines and health requirements found www.michigan.gov/mdard/animals/exhibitions/resources-for-exhibitors
- Show management reserves the right to excuse any animal from the show at any point for health issues.
- Out of State Sheep must have health papers available upon request
- All lambs must be shorn within 5 days of show
- Ewe lambs may show as commercial and market (must enter and pay in both divisions)
- The show committee, any volunteers associated with the show and the Hudsonville Community Fair Board are not responsible for losses from accidents or thefts.
