

Registration open to any youth 21 years of age and under as of January 1st of current year.

This show is sanctioned by the Michigan Club Lamb Association.

All animals must be checked in by 9:30 am to be eligible for show.

All animals must be free of signs of sickness, disease, and parasites, castrated, and have official USDA Identification ear tags.

Exhibitors shall at all times conduct themselves with honesty and good sportsmanship and reflect the highest standards of honor and dignity to promote the advancement of agricultural education.

All sheep must be slick sheared.

There will be no penning inside the barn.

Showmanship-

Divisions will be as follows: PeeWee (Up to 6 years old), Novice (7-11), Junior (12-14), Intermediate (15-17), and Senior (18-21).

Commercial Ewe Show-

Ewe lambs must be slicked. Classes will be determined by weight on the day of the show. 1st and 2nd place ewes from each class will be brought back to determine the Top 5 Commercial Ewes.

Commercial ewes may also enter the Market Show with a 2nd entry paid.

Market Show-

Classes will be determined by weight on the day of the show.

Divisions- Market Lambs will be split into black face and white face divisions, and then into weight divisions based on number of entries. First and second place animals in each class will be brought back to determine the division (light to heavy) grand and reserve champions.

Division grand and reserve champions will then be brought back for the pick of the Top 5 Market Lambs.
