

Scott Acker Classic Rules & Regulations

1. **Eligibility:** This show is sanctioned by MI Shows, MI Pigs and MCLA and is open to all youth that are 21 and under as of January 1, 2026.
2. **Entries:** Entry fees are a non-refundable \$30 per class for goat, sheep and swine, \$40 for beef. Showmanship will be \$10 per showman. Entries must be made **using the Showman App**. Late entries begin on June 1st, 2026 and increase by \$10 other than showmanship. Entries will be accepted until 9:00 am on that species show day.
3. **Check-In:** Check-in will be from 7 a.m. to 9 a.m each day. All registered animals must have corresponding registration papers. Goats and Sheep will declare weights and be reweighed prior to class entry with a 5lb variance. Swine will declare weights and swine at the top of each class will be reweighed at the judge's discretion with a 15lb variance allowed. Beef will be weighed at check in. All species excluding beef will be given a weight card to turn in declared weights at check in. Only original registration papers or digital registrations will be accepted. Animals that do not match registrations can be exhibited in commercial or crossbred classes. There will be no re-weighs.
4. **Showmanship:** All exhibitors are welcome to participate in showmanship. There is no cost for peewee showmanship and \$10 for all others. Age divisions are based on sanctioning guidelines per species.
5. **Dangerous Animals:** Animals must always be under the control of the exhibitor. Removal of an animal deemed dangerous will be at the discretion of the show committee and will be asked to leave immediately.
6. **Responsibility:** The Scott Acker Classic show committee, sponsors, and Isabella County Fairgrounds **WILL NOT** be responsible or liable, either directly or indirectly, for any injury to animals, or death thereof. The Scott Acker Classic show committee, sponsors, and Isabella County Fairgrounds **WILL NOT** be responsible or liable, either directly or indirectly for any loss or damage to the personal property, or personal injuries suffered on the premises or in connection with the show.
7. All rules and schedules of events are subject to change.
8. Unethical treatment of people or animals is strictly prohibited and will lead to immediate disqualification at the show committee's discretion.
9. Exhibitors are expected to clean their areas before leaving. A trash bag will be provided to exhibitors. All exhibitors are required to clean up waste around their trailers and dispose of it in manure pits.
