- Market lambs will show by white face or black face. Boers will show as wethers and does
- All lambs / goats must have USDA Scrapie ID Tag.
- Out of State animals need interstate health papers
- All lambs must be shorn within 5 days of show.
- Lambs **MAY** show from pens or off your trailer.
- Animals will show in the class they are assigned.
- The skillathons have no entry fee, but will pay premiums to the top 3 in each age group.
