## Double Lamb Show/Market Goat Show- Saturday May 31st, 2025 MCLA Sanctioned Show

### **Guidelines for Show**

- → All MCLA rules apply
- → Market lamb and showmanship classes are open to youth 21 and under as of January 1, 2024
- → Breeding stock classes are open class
- → All lambs will show by breed
- → All sheep must have USDA/ MDARD Scrapie ID tags/out of state sheep need interstate health papers
- → All lambs must be shorn within 5 days of show weigh-in
- → Animals exhibiting fungus, soremouth, or other contagious diseases are not allowed to show. Show manager has final say at check-in
- → Cash awards will be distributed the day of the show
- → Class premiums to top 3 in each showmanship class
- → ALL entries are non-refundable
- → We will offer a peewee showmanship for 6 years old and under (\$15 entry)
- → Classes will be determined by weight on the day of the show
- → Classes will be divided into equal numbers per class
- → Ewe lambs may be shown in commercial breeding ewe class as well as market (must pay 2 entry fees)
- → First and second-place animals in each class will be brought back to determine Grand and Reserve Champions
- → VBYF class must have a minimum of 5 in the class to payout.

#### **Goat Information**

- → Registration open to any youth 21 years of age and under as of January 1st of current year.
- → This show is sanctioned by the Michigan Club Goat Association Youth Challenge.
- → All animals must be checked in by 11 am to be eligible for show.
- → All animals must be free of signs of sickness, disease, and parasites, castrated, and have ocial USDA Identication ear tags.
- → Exhibitors shall at all times conduct themselves with honesty and good sportsmanship and reect the highest standards of honor and dignity to promote the advancement of agricultural education.
- → All market goats must be slick sheared.
- → Showmanship Divisions will be as follows: PeeWee (Up to 6 years old), Novice (7-11), Junior (12-14), Intermediate (15-17), and Senior (18-21).
- → Wether Dam Show Classes will be determined by weight on the day of the show.
- → 1st and 2nd place does from each class will be brought back to determine the Wether Dams.
- → Market Show Classes will be determined by weight on the day of the show.
- → First and second place animals in each class will be brought back to determine the division (light, medium, heavy, full blood) grand and reserve champions.
- → Division grand and reserve champions will then be brought back for the pick of the Top 5 Market Goats.
